The fund aims to provide combined income and capital growth that is higher than that of the global emerging markets stockmarket (as measured by the MSCI Emerging Markets Net Return Index) over any five-year period. At least 80% of the fund is invested in the shares of companies domiciled, or conducting the major part of their economic activity, in emerging market countries. Stock selection is driven by in-depth analysis of individual companies, with a specific focus on profits, corporate governance practices and valuation.
